## Advisory for Indian Nationals travelling to Egypt

All foreign travellers arriving in Egypt from 15<sup>th</sup> AUGUST will be required to submit a **negative PCR TEST CERTIFICATE** taken within the preceding **72 hours of arrival**.

- 2. Tourists arriving directly to the airports in the Red Sea, South Sinai and Marsa Matrouh governorates (i.e Hurghada, Marsa Allam, Sharm El-Sheikh and Marsa Matrouh airports) will be <u>exempted</u> from submitting PCR test report, and will be allowed to travel freely within the governorates. However, onward travel of such tourists to other governorates of Egypt; and travel of foreign nationals (excluding overseas transit arrivals) from other governorates to Red Sea, South Sinai and Marsa Matrouh governorates will require a **negative PCR TEST CERTIFICATE** taken within **72 hours prior to travel**.
- 3. Further, all arrivals to Egypt will be subject to local health measures. These may include temperature checks, completing a monitoring card with personal details and providing confirmation of valid health insurance policy, on arrival.
