## STUDENT SHOULD BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS :

- Duly **filled in application form** with photograph and signature.
- **Original documents** relating to their qualifications.
- Copies of all mark sheets for educational qualifications listed in the form.
- Certified copies of English Translation of the documents in original.
- **Certified copy of the syllabus of the last qualifying examination.**
- Valid passport with appropriate visa. Student visa for undergraduate/post graduate and research visa for Phd. Students.
- If the application is for B.E course, scholar should have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics(PCM) in his/her school leaving examination with minimum of 60%.
- Audio/ Video clip of those wishing to pursue courses in performing arts is uploaded.
- Synopsis of proposed area of research when applying for M.Phil./ Doctoral/ Postdoctoral course is uploaded.
- **D** Certificate of Physical fitness. (Original)
- **Local Police Verification (Criminal Record) (Original)**

## **PRE-DEPARTURE FORMALITIES**

- 1. BOOKING OF TICKETS
  - Students may ensure that there is sufficient gap between the timings of the connecting flights (5 to 6 hrs) in view of COVID -19 restrictions and delays.
  - □ There may be difference of baggage allowance in domestic and

international flights. **Students are advised to carry the baggage** equivalent to the limit of the lower category. In any case, <u>ICCR will not</u> pay any amount on account of baggage other than the domestic airlines baggage allowance.

- Immediately on purchase of ticket, the student should upload his Travel details on the <u>A2A portal</u> to enable ICCR's Regional Office make necessary arrangement for reception at airport.
- Student must adhere and keep updated as per the latest Covid Protocoll requirements such as RT-PCR test and quarantine requirements via following links : <u>Bureau of Immigration Advisory</u>, <u>Ministry of External</u> <u>Affairs</u>

## 2. OTHER NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS

- Medical insurance (Value of INR 500,000/-) is compulsory for the student at their cost. Student may buy medical insurance in his/her country or on their arrival in India. It is up to the student to chose the insurances package.
- Student may be advised to carry with him/her amount (at least equivalent to INR 50,000/-) to meet immediate expenses.
- Student may be advised to get himself/herself register with Foreign Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within a period of 14 days.

## 3. ABOUT THE ADMISSION:

Indian Universities/Educational institutes are autonomous and independent bodies and have their own eligibility criteria. Student's admission is considered provisional till the time universities satisfy themselves of the authenticity of requisite documents from the students. While travelling to India, Students **must possess the required original documents** based on which the admission has been finalized .
