

Auto Components

Tamil Nadu is amongst the top 10 automobile hubs in the world. The State is home to major global OEMs, accounts for 35% of India's auto & auto components production.



IT & ITES

Tamil Nadu is one of the India's largest IT hubs with 8 dedicated SEZs. The extensive IT infrastructure has made Chennai, the leading outsourcing hub and India's SaaS Capital.



Pharma & Bio-tech

The State houses more than 400+ pharma companies across segments like APIs, Formulations, CROs (Contract Research Organizations) & CMOs (Contract Manufacturing Companies)



Agro & Food Processing

Housing the highest number of agro and food processing units in India i.e., about 24,000 SMEs and 1,100 medium & large units, Tamil Nadu has a strong presence in the sector.



Electronics & Hardware

Tamil Nadu has received the highest FDI for electronics components in the last three years in India. With 20% share, the State stands 2nd in national electronics production.



Electric Vehicles, EV Cell & Battery Manufacturing

Tamil Nadu has emerged as India's EV manufacturing capital. Players across the EV supply chain are located in the State.



Leather & Footwear

With the major leather clusters in the State contributing to about 60% of India's total finished leather production, Tamil Nadu is the national leader in the sector.



Aerospace & Defence

The presence of major Defence PSUs along with 700+ other ancillary and downstream units form the entire supply chain in the State. The establishment of Tamil Nadu Defence Industrial Corridor has further bolstered the State's Defence Manufacturing ecosystem.



Heavy Engineering

Tamil Nadu has a strong engineering and capital goods base. The State is the 2nd largest exporter of heavy engineering goods & ranks 3rd in India in general purpose and special purpose machinery production.



General Manufacturing

Through nearly 3000 large units, Tamil Nadu provides employment to 2.5 lakh+ people in the sector. The State also contributes more than 20% to India's machine tools manufacturing output.



Chemicals & Petrochemicals

Tamil Nadu Single Window Portal (TNSWP) is a single point for acceptance and electronic distribution of applications to the respective competent authorities for subsequent processing, for all industrial approvals and clearances.

By providing 100+ digitized services across 24+ departments, it spares investors from running one department to other or having to submit the same set of information across multiple platforms.

The single window portal has been continuously upgraded to include new digitized G2B services, improving the Ease of Doing Business for investors in Tamil Nadu.






Salient Features of Tamil Nadu Electric Vehicle Policy 2019
