Notice inviting tender for procurement of musical instruments

The Maulana Azad Centre for Indian Culture (MACIC), Embassy of India, Cairo invites proposal for procurement of musical instruments as per the list mentioned in paragraph (B) below.

(A) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Bidders should demonstrate and explain their technical, professional and practical experience of having provided similar services and will need to submit examples of similar services provided in the last 03 years, including to any of the Indian Missions/Posts abroad or other Diplomatic Missions.
- 2. Bidders may also indicate their experience in this regard.
- 3. Bidders may also submit, in brief, the history of their company with annual turn over. They may also furnish the certificate license, if any that may indicate their qualification for providing musical instruments.
- 4. Bidders should ensure that the quotes should be provided to the Embassy by **1730 hrs** on **06 November 2024.**
- 5. To assist evaluation and comparison of the bids, the Embassy at its discretion, may ask the bidders for clarification on their bids. The clarifications and responses from the bidders shall be in writing.
- 6. If a bidder is asked to competitively quote for the same, the Embassy is not bound to accept the lowest quote or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and altering the numbers offered and the tenderer shall supply the same at the rate quoted.
- 7. Bidders should not have been barred / black-listed by the Governmental Department / Organization in India/Egypt or elsewhere (The bidder is requested to submit a self-declaration to this effect).
- 8. Bidders may submit their bids for providing the musical instruments in the Embassy.

- 4. Delivery of the musical instruments will be from Door to Door.

- Should have a large round body with a thick, wide neck, the end should be carved into the head of a dragon.
- The Veena should have 24 metal frets embedded in hardened bees-wax, mixed with charcoal powder.
- Long-necked, pear-shaped lute, but instead of the lower gourd of the North Indian design, it has a pear-shaped wooden piece.

- Neck and body are built in one piece made from strong bamboo.

- The bridge surface is made of ebony and the brigde feet and string holder end of hard wood.
- the strings are simply folded at the bridge end, threaded through a predrilled hole and fixated.
- No looping required while changing strings.
- Fine tuning beads (Mankas) made of hard wood allow for manual fine tuning in the traditional way.


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


